
Body Parts



Horizontally:

- 1. An organ of the body, into which food passes when swallowed.
- 2. The opening through which people take in food.
- 3. A hard, white, bone-like structure used for biting and chewing food.
- 4. The soft edge of the mouth.
- 5. An illness that causes a person to force air from the lungs with a sudden sound.
- 6. The part of the body that contains eyes a nose, a mouth and ears.
- 7. One of the two parts of the body used for standing and walking.
- 8. The force of blood as it travels round the body; it is taken to check a person's health.
- 9. The front part of the face below the mouth.
- 10. The part of the body from the shoulder to the hand.
- 11. The regular beating of blood through the body, it is felt on the wrist.

Vertically:

- 12. To put a hand on something.
- 13. A substance taken through the mouth to cure some illness or infection.
- 14. The upper, front part of the body.
- 15. One of the two organs of breathing in the chest of a man.
- 16. The part of the face used for breathing or smelling things.
- 17. It grows on the skin of people, especially on the head.
- 18. The central and the most important part of the body that plumps blood through the body.
- 19. A feeling of discomfort caused by illness in a particular part of the body.
- 20. The part of the body between the top of each arm and the neck
