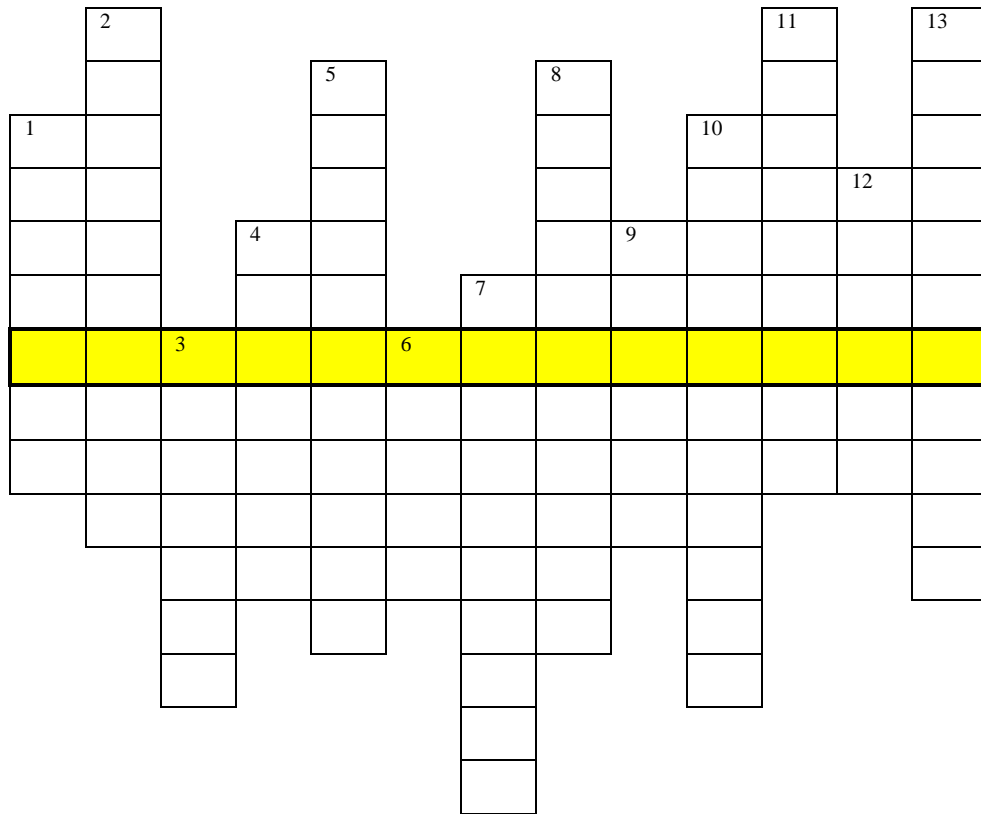


TYPES OF HOTELS
